### **BIPARTISAN BUDGET ACT OF 2018**

- Public Law 115-123
- Passed February 08, 2018
- Provides funding and authority for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to address impacts caused by natural disasters. The law emphasizes states impacted by Hurricanes Harvey, Irma, and Maria
- Appropriates \$15,055,000,00
- \$2,546,757,000 for Puerto Rico
- All projects in Puerto Rico shall be at full federal expense
- Projects in Metropolitan San Juan:
  - Rio Puerto Nuevo Project
  - Rio Puerto Nuevo Dredging
  - San Juan Metro Coastal Study
- \$ 1,552,453,000 \$ 8,300,000
  - 8,300,000 3,000,000

# **RPN PROJECT OVERVIEW**

- TOTAL PROJECT COST OF \$2.636 BILLION
- BASIN DRAINS 24 SQUARE MILES (75% HIGHLY DEVELOPED)
- POPULATION OF 250,000 AFFECTED
- 7,000 RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES, 800 COMMERCIAL AND PUBLIC STRUCTURES VALUED AT OVER \$3 BILLION TO INCLUDE THE CITY'S MAJOR TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES, PR MAIN PORT FACILITIES, RECREATION FACILITIES, GOVERNMENT OFFICES, PREPA ELECTRICAL POWER PLANT, AND SEVERAL WASTEWATER/WATER TREATMENT FACILITIES
- PROJECT CONSTRUCTION WOULD GENERATE OVER \$80M IN MUNICIPAL TAXES AND THOUSANDS OF DIRECT AND INDIRECT CONSTRUCTION RELATED JOBS.
- THE PLAN OF IMPROVEMENT INCLUDES:
  - CONSTRUCTION OF 1.7 MILES OF EARTH LINED CHANNEL
  - 9.5 MILES OF CONCRETE LINED CHANNELS (5.1 HIGH VELOCITY)
  - 2 DEBRIS BASINS

  - CONSTRUCTION OF 5 NEW BRIDGES
  - REPLACEMENT OF 17 BRIDGES
  - MODIFICATION OF 8 EXISTING BRIDGES
  - MITIGATION FOR THE LOSS OF ENVIRONMENTAL HABITATS (COMPLETED)




